

## **DENTPIN® - Why You Need One**

A DENTPIN® (DENTal Personal Identifier Number) is a unique identifier used by professionals and students involved in the U.S. dental education system and standardized testing programs. If you have tested or applied to test, a DENTPIN has been assigned to you, which can be retrieved at <a href="https://www.ada.org/en/education-careers/dentpin.">https://www.ada.org/en/education-careers/dentpin.</a>

You must retrieve or register for a DENTPIN® to apply to dental education programs or application services, to apply for testing, or to request a score report. It's important that the name on your identification card (ID) matches exactly with the name in your DENTPIN® record. A mismatch will result in denial of admission to testing, forfeiture of your testing appointment and fee, and the requirement to submit a new application and fee.
